ACETYLCYSTEINE (MUCOMYST)

Date: December 2017

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Acetycysteine (Mucomyst)

Indications:

Acetaminophen (Tylenol) poisoning

Actions:

Antidote for acetaminophen (Tylenol) poisoning

Contra-indications:

Hypersensitivity, caution if upper GI bleed risk.

Adverse Effects:

Bronchospasm, nausea, vomiting, rash, tachycardia, flushing

puritis.

Administration:

Start 150 mg/kg IV x 1 over 60 minutes, then 50 mg/kg IV x 1

over 4 hrs, then 100 mg/kg IV x 1 over 16 hours.

MICU Directives:

1. Follow generalized protocol for MICU transports.

2. Continue at drip rate determined by the sending facility.

3. Frequently assess for undesirable effects, discontinue drip if adverse reactions occur.
