## MILRINONE (COROTROPE, PRIMACOR)

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## Milrinone (Corotrope, Primacor)

**Indications**:

Short-term management of congestive heart failure.

Contra-indications:

Hypersensitivity.

Adverse Effects:

Headache, ventricular arrhythmias

Administration:

Initial IV loading dose of 50 mcg/kg over 10 minutes followed by an infusion of 0.375 - 0.75 mcg/kg/min. (mix 20mg Milrinone in

80 ml/D5W). Maximum dose 1.13 mg/kg/day.

## **MICU Directives:**

- 1. Follow generalized protocol for MICU transports.
- 2. Maintain appropriate delivery rate by IV infusion pump.
- 3. Monitor vital signs every 5-10 minutes.
- 4. Discontinue and notify appropriate medical direction facility if patient develops severe hypotension or hypersensitivity occurs.
- 5. If an invasive arterial line monitoring device is present and compatible with MICU equipment, continue monitoring during transport.

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
